Jim Smith is the winningest college coach in Minnesota basketball history. And yet, perhaps his most important accomplishment was the one Smith referenced when he retired in 2015:

- Sustain the strength and stability of the program
- Enhance the program by infusing it with the resources to enhance that player experience for future generations

He built a family. And there could be no better honor for a family man than to pay it forward.


